STUDENT TRAVEL CONCESSION CARD CONDITIONS OF ISSUE AND USAGE

1. Cards may be issued to all students (excepting school pupils aged 16, 17 and 18 years) who have attained 16 years of age; attend day classes at an educational establishment registered with Rail Corporation New South Wales; are fully engaged in studies; are not full fee paying overseas students; not engaged in business or employment; and not in receipt of remuneration. (Scholarships, allowances and similar awards are exempt from the definition of remuneration).
2. By arrangement with Rail Corporation, issue of cards to eligible students will be made by Universities and T.A.F.E. Colleges. Where issues are not made by an Educational Establishment, the application form must be completed, certified by the Institution attended and forwarded to the PASSES AND CONCESSIONS OFFICE, RAIL CORPORATION NSW, 490 PITT STREET, SYDNEY. POSTAL ADDRESS: PO BOX K349 HAYMARKET NSW 1238. TELEPHONE: (02) 9379 4441. A STAMPED SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPE must be forwarded with the application if the card is to be posted to the applicant's address.
3. Cards are not valid for use unless signed by the student to whom issued and all details are shown in the spaces provided; if there is any alteration, erasure or addition; if the card is torn, damaged or mutilated.
4. Cards must be shown when purchasing tickets, or on demand, to any authorized employee of either Transport Authority, otherwise full adult fare must be paid.
5. Expired cards will not be recognised for any travel concession.
6. Cards are not transferable. (Any person other than the person to whom Card is issued, using or being irregularly in possession thereof, is liable to prosecution and any person who allows any other person to use card is also liable to prosecution).
7. Falsification of Declaration or breach of any of the above conditions may result in withdrawal of the Identification Card, and may render the student liable to prosecution and to forfeiture of all travel concession privileges.
8. Cards lost, mutilated, destroyed or stolen will be replaced by the Passes and Concessions Office on presentation of a new application form and payment of the prescribed fee.
9. The card must be surrendered if the student can no longer comply by the eligibility criteria shown above.
