NIGHT WORK ON THE NORTHERN DISTRIBUTOR

Wednesday 12 August 2009

Member for Keira David Campbell said essential roadwork would be carried out on the Northern Distributor from tonight.

Mr Campbell said the \$420,000 NSW Government upgrade on one of the Illawarra's major roads is great news for local motorists.

"These works will improve the road surface for local drivers and extend the life of the road," Mr Campbell said.

"Work involves resurfacing the northbound lanes of the Northern Distributor between Graham Avenue, Gwynneville and the Princes Highway overpass at North Wollongong, including the off-ramp.

"This project is part of the NSW Government's commitment to maintaining the condition of the State road network now and into the future.

"The Northern Distributor is used by up to 30,000 vehicles during the day so work will be done at night to minimise the impact on motorists."

Mr Campbell said the work would be done from 7pm to 4am on Wednesday 12 August 2009 and Thursday 13 August 2009, weather permitting.

"One out of three lanes on the Northern Distributor will be closed, however motorists will still be able to access North Wollongong via the off-ramp," Mr Campbell said.

"Motorists are asked to travel through the worksite at a reduced speed of 40km/h, which will be clearly marked.

"I'd like to thank motorists for their patience while this essential work is being done."
