## HAVE YOUR SAY ON BUS NETWORK

19 October 2009

State Member for the Blue Mountains Phil Koperberg today encouraged locals to have their say on a proposed new bus network for the region.

Mr Koperberg said the proposed network incorporated comments received from local representatives and now broader community feedback was being sought.

“The Government is seeking feedback from local bus users about whether the proposed bus network meets their needs,” Mr Koperberg said.

“The proposed changes are aimed at delivering improved travel options and a simplified bus route structure.

“We want to provide the right bus services for people so they can get where they want to go by public transport rather than resorting to using a car.

“Those interested can pick up a flyer from the Blue Mountains Bus Company, onboard buses and from the local library, council office or shopping centre.”

Mr Koperberg said it was easy to provide feedback.

“Simply read the flyer, fill out the attached survey and send it back,” Mr Koperberg said.

“You can also call 1800 005 113 and give your feedback there, all of the comments will be collated and given consideration.

“Submissions close on 16 November 2009, so be sure to share your comments before then.”
