VISIT SCULPTURE BY THE SEA BY BUS

Friday 30 October 2009

Minister for Transport David Campbell today said Sydney Buses was making it easy and hassle-free for people to visit the coastal sculpture exhibition *Sculpture by the Sea*.

Mr Campbell said Sydney Buses had increased the frequency of weekend bus services to Tamarama for people wanting to visit the exhibition.

“The 13th annual *Sculpture by the Sea* exhibition will feature 100 sculptures from Australia and around the world,” Mr Campbell said.

“The easiest and most relaxing way to get to the *Sculpture by the Sea* exhibition is by bus.

“This free event is running until 15 November 2009 along the spectacular cliff-face walk between Bondi Beach and Tamarama. Buses travel frequently from the city and from the Bondi Junction Interchange, taking you right to the beach.”

Mr Campbell said people could catch the following bus routes to the *Sculpture by the Sea* exhibition:

- Route 333 – from Circular Quay to Bondi Beach
- Route 380 - from Circular Quay to Bondi Beach
- Route 361 – Bondi Junction to Tamarama.

“Route 333, 380 and 361 run seven days a week,” Mr Campbell said.

“For those people catching a train to Bondi Junction, Sydney Buses has increased the frequency of the Route 361 with it running every 15 minutes on weekends and every 30 minutes on weekdays.

“The blue hop-on, hop-off Bondi Explorer is another option – you can spend a day exploring 19 of Sydney’s harbour and coastal highlights, and see the exhibition by hopping off at Bondi Beach or Bronte Beach.”
