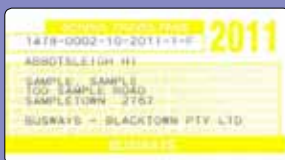

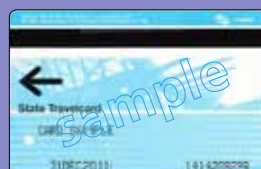

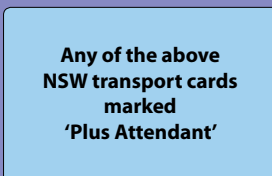

Children under 4 years of age

- No card required

Students

- All cards must show a RailCorp sticker or symbol with the exception of Proof of Age card
- Card design varies by institution
- Some cards may have a PrePay facility with a financial institution logo
- NSW Transport Concession cards – entitlement expires as dated on the card
- Concessions on student ID cards expire 31 March 2012
- SSTS pass is valid for travel to/from home/school only

Attendants

- Free attendant travel is only available when the card holder with disability is being assisted

Pensioners

- Pensioner Concession Cards are issued by Centrelink or the Department of Veterans Affairs, and are varied eg: Aged, Disabled, Carer, Single parent
- Seniors Cards are issued by States/Territories for people aged 60 and over

Assistance Animals

- Cards are issued by RailCorp
- Guide Dogs, Hearing Dogs (accredited by Lions Australia Hearing Dogs) and Police Dogs are not required to have a card
