This guide is to help taxi drivers prepare for the Sydney Knowledge and Regulation Test.

As a Taxi driver, you are required to have a good knowledge of the City of Sydney, as well as the surrounding suburbs, major routes and places of interest. You must also have a good knowledge of the rules and regulations, including the road rules relating to your role as a taxi driver. You are expected to know how to use a street directory quickly and effectively.

The Sydney Knowledge and Regulation Test is designed to assess your knowledge and skills in these areas. There are 5 Sections in the test and it is essential that you study the information in this guide in order to pass this test. This test is updated on a regular basis, so please ensure you have the current version of this guide. You must pass this test before completing your TaxiCare Plus Course.

Introduction

PROCEDURES AND INSTRUCTIONS

You must bring the following items with you when you **first** sit for the Sydney Knowledge and Regulation Test.

- Photo ID Card – completed and signed
- English Assessment Form
- Current Driver's Licence
- Certificate of Readiness for NSW Transport and Infrastructure's Test from your training school
- Completed Training Workbooks 2, 8 & 9 for Module Two of the currently approved training course, declaration signed by your Registered Training Organisation (RTO).
- Receipt / Invoice from your Registered Training Organisation (RTO)
- Provided proof of eligibility – passport / birth certificate or citizenship certificate.

After entering the testing room, you will be asked to:

- Turn off your mobile phone and give it to the testing officer
- Hand over any bags, papers, notes, street directories etc. that you have with you (These items will be placed in a visible position.)

You will be under observation by NSW Transport and Infrastructure staff during the test. Any applicant caught cheating may not be considered to be of good repute or a fit and proper person to be the driver of a public passenger vehicle and may not be permitted to re-sit the test.

The testing officer will explain the procedures and ensure that you fully understand the test requirements.

In the event of test booking cancellation, you must notify NSW Transport and Infrastructure and then contact your school to reschedule your test booking.

INSTRUCTIONS

This is a computer-based test. The questions you will be given are selected at random by the computer from a databank of 700 questions. The following information will appear on your screen as soon as the testing officer has logged you on.

ABOUT THE TEST

You have a total of 44 minutes to complete Sections 1 to 4. Section 5 is a practical street directory test, which you have 16 minutes to complete.

Section 1 - Street Knowledge	(10 Questions - 8 mins)	2 errors

Section 3 - Locations and Destinations	(20 Questions - 13 mins)	4 errors

Section 5 - Street Directory Test	(8 Questions - 16 mins)	0 errors

ANSWERING QUESTIONS

Please read each question carefully.

To answer a question, use the <Tab> key to highlight the answer you believe is right and press the <Enter> key to select it.

PRACTICE TEST

There is a short practice test for you to become familiar with the types of questions and how to answer them. The practice test contains four questions selected at random. The questions do not count towards your final score, and there is no time limit on the practice questions. At the end of the Practice Test, a message will come on the screen explaining that Section 1 is about to start – press the <Enter> key.

PROCEDURES FOR THE TEST

YOUR TEST WILL COMMENCE IMMEDIATELY. Ensure you read each question carefully and be mindful of the time as there is a time limit for each section.

Note: There is a clock in the top right hand corner of the screen for your convenience.

If you pass a section, you will be congratulated and can move on to the next section. If you answer more than the allowed number of questions incorrectly, you will have failed that section of the test. Press the <Enter> key and move on to the next section of the test. The first time you sit for the test you will sit for each section.

After you finish Section 4, press the button on the wall and leave it on. The testing officer will test you on Section 5 – Street Directory Test. You will be asked 8 questions, selected at random, and the testing officer will type your answers into the computer.

At the completion of the test, you will be given your results. If you pass, you need to return to your school to complete your course. If you fail one or more sections of the test, you will be issued with a Test Report giving your results in each section. You will only be re-tested on the sections that you failed. Your school will book you in to be re-tested on those sections. When you have passed all sections of the test, you will be issued with a certificate.

If you are not satisfied with the result of a test, you should discuss the matter with your nominated training school, who can then liaise with NSWTI directly. Applicants who fail to follow instructions from NSWTI staff both during, and at the conclusion of, the Sydney Knowledge Test may jeopardise their application for a taxi-cab authority.

COLLECTING YOUR TAXI DRIVER AUTHORITY CARD

Prior to a driver authority card being issued, you must provide the following items to NSW Transport and Infrastructure:

- PART A of the CERTIFICATE III in TAXI DRIVING - TAXICARE PLUS
- Practical Driving / Customer Service / Holistic Assessment Check List

Section 1 – Street Knowledge

Section 1 is designed to assess your knowledge of major streets in the Sydney CBD, inner suburbs, Chatswood, North Sydney and Parramatta areas. Major streets used in the Test are those defined in your street directory as Freeways and Motorways, Main Roads, Secondary Roads and Major Local Roads.

You need to know where a street begins and ends, and for one way streets, the direction in which they run. You also need to know the entrance and exit lanes to and from the Sydney Harbour Bridge and Tunnel.

There are 10 computer-based multiple-choice questions, to be completed in 8 minutes. A maximum of 2 errors is allowed.

Note: If you give 3 incorrect answers you will have failed this section of the test. Press the <Enter> key and move on to the next section.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS:

CROWN STREET runs from

- a) Sir John Young Crescent to Cleveland Street.
- b) Jamison Street, to Grosvenor Street.
- c) Liverpool Street, to Foveaux Street.
- d) Devonshire Street, to Albion Street.

Answer: a) Sir John Young Crescent.to Cleveland Street.

CASTLEREAGH STREET, between HUNTER STREET and HAY STREET runs one way in which direction?

- a) East to West.
- b) South to North.
- c) West to East.
- d) North to South.

Answer: d) North to South.

EDDY AVENUE runs from Pitt Street, to Elizabeth Street.
ELIZABETH STREET runs from Hunter Street, to Joynton Avenue, Zetland.
ERSKINE STREET runs from Lime Street, to York Street.
GOULBURN STREET runs from Harbour Street to Crown Street, Surry Hills.
GRESHAM STREET runs from Bent Street, to Bridge Street.
GROSVENOR STREET runs from York Street, to George Street.
HOSPITAL ROAD runs from Art Gallery Road, to Shakespeare Place.
HUNTER STREET runs from Macquarie Street, to George Street.
KENT STREET runs from Liverpool Street, to Windmill Street.
KING STREET runs from Lime Street, to Phillip Street.
MACQUARIE STREET runs from Bennelong Point, to St James Road.
MARGARET STREET runs from Kent Street, to George Street.
MARKET STREET runs from Elizabeth Street, to Sussex Street.
O'CONNELL STREET runs from Bent Street, to Hunter Street.
PHILLIP STREET runs from Alfred Street, to King Street.
PITT STREET runs from Alfred Street, to George Street.
SPRING STREET runs from Pitt Street, to Gresham Street.
SUSSEX STREET runs from Napoleon Street, to Hay Street.
WENTWORTH AVENUE runs from Liverpool Street, to Elizabeth Street.
YORK STREET runs from Grosvenor Street, to Druitt Street.

SYDNEY CBD – One Way Streets

BATHURST STREET runs one way from West to East.

CASTLEREAGH STREET, between HUNTER STREET and HAY STREET runs one way from North to South.

CLARENCE STREET runs one way from South to North.

DRUITT STREET runs one way from East to West.

HAY STREET, SYDNEY, between GEORGE STREET and HARBOUR STREET, runs one way from East to West.

JAMISON STREET, between GEORGE STREET and YORK STREET runs one way from East to West.

KING STREET between SUSSEX STREET and ELIZABETH STREET, runs one way from West to East. .

LIVERPOOL STREET, between ELIZABETH STREET and HARBOUR STREET, runs one way from East to West.

LOFTUS STREET, between BRIDGE STREET and ALFRED STREET runs one way from South to North.

MARKET STREET, between ELIZABETH STREET and GEORGE STREET, runs one way from East to West.

PITT STREET, between ALFRED STREET and KING STREET runs one way from North to South.

PITT STREET, between GOULBURN STREET and MARKET STREET, runs one way from South to North.

YORK STREET runs one way from North to South.

INNER SUBURBAN SYDNEY

CHALMERS STREET runs from Phillip Street, Redfern, to Elizabeth Street.

CLEVELAND STREET runs from City Road, to Anzac Parade.

COWPER WHARF ROADWAY, WOOLLOOMOOLOO runs from Wylde Street, to Sir John Young Crescent.

CROWN STREET runs from Sir John Young Crescent, to Cleveland Street.

DARLINGHURST ROAD, KINGS CROSS runs from Oxford Street, to Macleay Street.

FOVEAUX STREET runs from Bourke Street, to Elizabeth Street.

HARRIS STREET runs from Pirrama Road, Pyrmont to Broadway, Ultimo.

MACLEAY STREET runs from Wylde Street, to Darlinghurst Road.

MOORE PARK ROAD runs from South Dowling Street, to Oxford Street.

OCEAN STREET, WOOLLAHRA runs from Oxford Street, to New South Head Road.

PIER STREET runs from Darling Drive, to Harbour Street.

QUEEN STREET, WOOLLAHRA runs from Oxford Street, to Edgecliff Road.

SOUTH DOWLING STREET, MOORE PARK runs from Oxford Street, to Link Road.

ULTIMO ROAD, HAYMARKET runs from Harris Street, to George Street.

VICTORIA STREET runs from MacDonald Lane, to Oxford Street.

WATTLE STREET runs from Broadway, to Pyrmont Bridge Road.

WENTWORTH PARK ROAD runs from Bay Street, to Bridge Road.

WILLIAM STREET runs from College Street, to Darlinghurst Road.

INNER SUBURBAN SYDNEY– One Way

ALBION STREET, SURRY HILLS between MARY STREET and FLINDERS STREET, runs one way from West to East.

FITZROY STREET, SURRY HILLS between SOUTH DOWLING STREET and BOURKE STREET, runs one way from East to West.

VICTORIA STREET, DARLINGHURST between CRAIGEND STREET and OXFORD STREET, runs one way from North to South.

HARBOUR BRIDGE AND TUNNEL

The last on-ramp for the Northern end of the SYDNEY HARBOUR TUNNEL is at Falcon Street.

The last on-ramp for the Southern end of the SYDNEY HARBOUR TUNNEL is at the intersection of Palmer Street and Sir John Young Crescent.

When crossing the Harbour Bridge, to exit at FALCON STREET from the WARRINGAH FREEWAY, you should be in lane Two or Three.

When taking the CITY NORTH EXIT off the Harbour Bridge, you should be in lane Seven.

When taking the CITY SOUTH EXIT off the Harbour Bridge, you should be in lane Seven.

When taking the PACIFIC HIGHWAY, NORTH SYDNEY EXIT off the Harbour Bridge you should be in lanes One or Two.

NORTH SYDNEY AREA

ARTHUR STREET, NORTH SYDNEY between BERRY STREET and MOUNT STREET runs **one way** from North to South.

BERRY STREET, NORTH SYDNEY between PACIFIC HIGHWAY and ARTHUR STREET runs **one way** from West to East.

FALCON STREET, NORTH SYDNEY runs from Pacific Highway, to Military Road.

LAVENDER STREET, NORTH SYDNEY runs from Blues Point Road, to Alfred Street.

McLAREN STREET, NORTH SYDNEY runs from Pacific Highway, to Walker Street.

MILLER STREET, NORTH SYDNEY runs from Blue Street, to The Boulevard.

PARRAMATTA AREA

ARGYLE STREET, PARRAMATTA runs from Pitt Street, to Valentine Avenue.

CHURCH STREET, PARRAMATTA runs from North Rocks Road, to Parramatta Road.

GEORGE STREET, PARRAMATTA between O'CONNELL STREET and ALFRED STREET, runs **one way** from West to East.

O'CONNELL STREET, PARRAMATTA runs from Board Street, to Great Western Highway.

PARKES STREET, PARRAMATTA runs from Church Street, to Purchase Street.

PHILLIP STREET, PARRAMATTA runs from Marsden Street, to Charles Street.

MACQUARIE STREET, PARRAMATTA runs from Harris Street, to Pitt Street.

PITT STREET, PARRAMATTA between GREAT WESTERN HIGHWAY & MACQUARIE STREET, runs **one way** from South to North.

CHATSWOOD AREA

ALBERT AVENUE, CHATSWOOD runs from Stanley Street, to Pacific Highway.

ARCHER STREET, CHATSWOOD runs from Mowbray Road, to Boundary Street.

HELP STREET, CHATSWOOD runs from Pacific Highway, to Anderson Street.

RAILWAY STREET, CHATSWOOD runs from Pacific Highway, to Victoria Avenue.

VICTORIA AVE, CHATSWOOD runs from Eastern Valley Way, to Pacific Highway.

Section 2 – Major Routes

This Section is designed to assess your knowledge of major routes in the greater metropolitan area of Sydney. You will be expected to know the major route from one suburb to another suburb, or from a major tourist destination to any suburb in Sydney. Major routes between suburbs include freeways, motorways, main roads, secondary roads and major local roads.

There are 10 computer-based multiple-choice questions to be completed in 8 minutes. A maximum of 2 errors is allowed.

Note: If you give 3 incorrect answers you will have failed this section of the test. Press the <Enter> key and move on to the next section.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS:

In travelling from CENTRAL RAILWAY STATION to BONDI BEACH, along which of the following would you proceed in part of your journey?

- a) Anzac Parade.
- b) Princes Highway.
- c) Moore Park Road.
- d) Alison Road.

Answer: c) Moore Park Road.

In travelling from SYLVANIA to MIRANDA, which of the following would you proceed along?

- a) President Avenue.
- b) Port Hacking Road.
- c) Princes Highway.
- d) Taren Point Road.

Answer: b) Port Hacking Road.

It is essential that you know the major routes listed in the following pages to give yourself every opportunity to pass the test.

CITY, EAST & SOUTH EAST

SOUTH & SOUTH WEST

From ARNCLIFFE to HURSTVILLE, you would use Forest Road.

From BEVERLY HILLS to BEXLEY, you would use Stoney Creek Road.

From BLAKEHURST to PUNCHBOWL, you would use King Georges Road.

From BRIGHTON le SANDS to MASCOT, you would use General Holmes Drive.

From CARSS PARK to ARNCLIFFE, you would use Princes Highway.

From DOLLS POINT to KYEEMAGH, you would use The Grand Parade.

From GYMEA to CRONULLA, you would use Kingsway.

From LIVERPOOL to CONDELL PARK, you would use Newbridge Road in part of your journey.

From LIVERPOOL to ENGADINE, you would use Heathcote Road.

From MENAI to PADSTOW HEIGHTS, you would use Alfords Point Road.

MOTORWAYS

From SYDNEY AIRPORT to KINGS CROSS, if the passenger is willing to pay the toll, you would use the Eastern Distributor.

From NORTH SYDNEY to SEVEN HILLS, if the passenger is willing to pay the toll, you would use the M2.

From HURSTVILLE to LIVERPOOL, if the passenger is willing to pay the toll, you would use the M5.

Section 3 – Locations and Destinations

Section 3 is designed to assess your knowledge of important locations and destinations in the Sydney metropolitan area. You will need to identify the location of important places such as Hospitals, Hotels, Clubs and other significant places of interest, which are sourced from Street Directories and Tourism NSW.

There are 20 computer-based multiple-choice questions to be completed in 13 minutes. A maximum of 4 errors is allowed.

Note: If you give 5 incorrect answers you will have failed this section of the test. Press the <Enter> key and move on to the next section.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS:

STATE THEATRE is in

- a) Liverpool Street, near Elizabeth Street, Sydney.
- b) Market Street, near Pitt Street, Sydney.
- c) Goulburn Street, near George Street, Sydney.

MONA VALE HOSPITAL is in

DOMESTIC TERMINAL, SYDNEY AIRPORT (KINGSFORD SMITH) is located near the intersection of Qantas Drive and Sir Reginald Ansett Drive, Mascot.

INTERNATIONAL TERMINAL, SYDNEY AIRPORT (KINGSFORD SMITH) is located on Airport Drive, Mascot.

CEMETERIES

NORTHERN SUBURBS CREMATORIUM is in Delhi Road, North Ryde.

ROOKWOOD NECROPOLIS (CEMETERY) is in East Street, Lidcombe.

CHURCHES & PLACES OF WORSHIP

Section 4 is designed to assess your knowledge of the Passenger Transport Regulation 2007. You should be familiar with all clauses concerning the operation of a taxi-cab. You will be questioned on the followings sections of the regulation:

There are 10 computer-based multiple-choice questions to be completed in 15 minutes. A maximum of 1 error will be allowed.

Note: If you give 2 incorrect answers you will have failed this section of the test. Press the <Enter> key and move on to the next section.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS

A taxi driver is permitted to:

- a) allow the taxi-cab to display the night-time surcharge before 10.00 p.m.
- b) eat or drink in the taxi-cab, if not hired but available for hire.
- c) move the taxi-cab while the doors are open.
- d) smoke tobacco outside and within 3 metres of the taxi-cab.

Answer: d) smoke tobacco outside and within 3 metres of the taxi-cab.

A taxi driver does not need to notify the Director-General of:

- a) a parking offence.
- b) a speeding offence.
- c) a driving under the influence of alcohol offence.
- d) a negligent driving offence.

Answer: a) a parking offence.

A passenger waiting at a taxi-zone:

- a) must take the first taxi-cab in the taxi-zone.
- b) may take any taxi-cab in the taxi-zone.
- c) must take the last taxi-cab in the taxi-zone.
- d) must wait to be told which taxi-cab to take.

Answer: b) may take any taxi-cab in the taxi-zone.

It is essential that you know and understand the Regulation and have studied the list of essential vocabulary to give yourself every opportunity to pass the test.

Section 5 – Street Directory

Section 5 is designed to assess your ability to use a street directory quickly and effectively. You will need to be very familiar with the contents and index of the street directory. You must use the street directory supplied by NSW Transport and Infrastructure. There are Fixed-Point (LOCATE) and Point to Point (DEMONSTRATE) questions.

Fixed Point Questions (LOCATE)

You must find the location in the index first and then the location on the correct map reference.

Point to Point Questions (DEMONSTRATE)

- You must not mark the street directory at any time with a pen or pencil.
- You may use the key maps in the front of the street directory to assist in identifying the shortest route, but may not use them to answer the question.
- After locating each point in the index, you must locate the correct maps, show the testing officer the first point and then demonstrate the SHORTEST route to the second point.
- You will be expected to name the main roads you would travel along.
- You may use Motorways, but must inform the testing officer that the passenger must be consulted first and be willing to pay the toll.
- The testing officer will terminate the test and you will have failed if you:
 - a) point to the wrong street or location.
 - b) travel along anything other than a road or bridge e.g. a railway line, river etc.
 - c) travel the wrong way along a one-way street.
 - d) travel across parks or waterways.
 - e) use a “cul-de-sac” or “no through” road as a through street.
 - f) fail to demonstrate the SHORTEST route.

There are 8 questions, 4 locate and 4 demonstrate to be completed in 16 minutes. No errors allowed.

Note: If you give any incorrect answers your test will cease immediately and you will have failed. After completing Section 5 you will be given a Report with the results of all sections.

Locate the ENSEMBLE THEATRE.

DEMONSTRATE
