



Gold Senior/Pensioner Opal card customer information kiosks

- Information kiosks are available for seniors and pensioners to get information about Opal and order their Gold Senior/Pensioner Opal card.
- Staff are available at the kiosk to take customers through the Gold Opal card application process. Customers can leave the kiosk knowing their application is underway and their Gold Opal card will be mailed directly to their home within about 5 working days.
- The kiosks will operate at the convenient hours of 9.00am to 4.00pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday plus the extended hours of 9.00am to 8.00pm on Thursday.
- Seniors and pensioners do not need a credit card or access to the internet to get an Opal card, but they do need their NSW Seniors card, Pensioner Concession card or NSW War Widows card.
