More than 97 per cent of trains on time on major lines in April

More than 97 per cent of peak trains were on time on four of Sydney's major train lines in April, including the T4 Eastern Suburbs Line at over 99 per cent peak punctuality.

Across the network trains achieved 95.7 per cent peak punctuality, comfortably exceeding the 92 per cent target.

Sydney Trains' Chief Executive Howard Collins said that last month's figures were a pleasing result.

"The majority of our lines performed very well in April, with four exceeding 97 per cent," Mr Collins said.

"Our best performing line was the Eastern Suburbs with 99.1 per cent punctuality, followed by the T4 Illawarra Line at 97.8 per cent, the T3 Bankstown Line at 97.5 per cent and the T2 Inner West at 97.2 per cent."

Three lines just missed out meeting the 92 per cent target in April. The T2 South Line achieved 91.9 per cent, the T1 Northern Line via Strathfield achieved 91.7 per cent and the T1 Western Line achieved 91.2 per cent.
