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All lines beat Sydney Trains punctuality target in September

Every Sydney Trains line exceeded its peak punctuality target in September, with more than 95 per cent of peak trains on time across the entire Sydney Trains network in September.

Sydney Trains Chief Executive Howard Collins said last month's figures are a very pleasing result.

"All of our lines performed extremely well in September, with an overall peak punctuality of 95.6 per cent," Mr Collins said.

"Three of our busiest lines exceeded 98 per cent punctuality, including the T3 Bankstown, the T4 Eastern Suburbs and the T2 Inner West lines.

"We know there's more work to do, but we're very proud to be consistently improving reliability, particularly across our 638 peak daily services.

"We're also becoming more efficient and effective with our maintenance program, reducing weekend trackwork by 35 per cent over the last two financial years while continuing to make our trains more reliable for customers."
