2015/16 SYDNEY ANNUAL TAXI LICENCE DETERMINATION

Section 32C, Passenger Transport Act 1990

I, Timothy Peter Reardon, A/Secretary of the Department of Transport, on behalf of Transport for NSW hereby determine under section 32C(1) of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990* as follows

The number of annual licences to be issued for taxi-cabs during the year commencing on 1 July 2015 is one hundred and twelve (112).

The 112 annual licences are to comprise the following:

- A. Two (2) licences of fringe area class to replace existing annual licences of this class for Windsor/Richmond that were returned to Roads and Maritime Services.
- B. Seventy one (71) licences of peak availability class, of which replace existing annual peak availability licences which were or are expected to be returned to Roads and Maritime Services.
- C. Thirty nine (39) licences of unrestricted class, all of which replace existing annual licences which were or are expected to be returned to Roads and Maritime Services.

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxi-cabs (section 32C(7)).

Defined terms

In this Determination:

fringe area class means a licence that may operate wholly within a defined geographic area as specified in the licence details and in accordance with the licence conditions.

Metropolitan transport district has the same meaning as in the *Transport Administration Act 1988.*

peak availability class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only at times specified in the licence conditions.

unrestricted class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only and has no other operating restrictions.

All other terms in this Determination have the meaning provided for in the *Passenger Transport Act 1990.*
