
**Pendle Hill Station Upgrade** 

# **COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION**

# **DECEMBER 2017**

Transport for NSW has made changes at Pendle Hill Station to improve access for customers. The project includes four new lifts, a new station concourse and footbridge, new stairs, platform canopies and a family accessible toilet.

Works for the station upgrade are expected to be complete by the end of December 2017, with the remaining section of the pre-existing footbridge to be removed this month.

# Weekend work - Saturday 16 December to Sunday 17 December 2017

The following work will be undertaken during a Sydney Trains scheduled trackwork weekend (for information on rail services during the weekend, kindly contact the Transport Infoline on 131500):


- removal of pre-existing footbridge prior to the station upgrade and associated services, including electrical wiring
- minor resurfacing works on all platforms.

From 1am Saturday 16 December to 10pm Sunday 17 December 2017, the following changes will apply to enable a crane to be assembled and used during the weekend works:

## Road closures and traffic changes

- Joyce Street will be closed between Goodall Street and Pendle Way
- Pendle Way will be closed between Joyce Street and Civic Avenue
- traffic diversions will be in place via Goodall Street, Dunmore Street and Pendle Way.

These changes are detailed in the map below:



Vehicle access along Joyce Street and Pendle Way to business and residential properties will be maintained with traffic control to assist with vehicle movements.

## Changes to taxi services

The taxi stand located on Joyce Street (adjacent to the station) will be relocated to the east side of Pendle Way (between Pendle Way and Civic Avenue).

# **Changes to Hillsbus services**

Hillsbus services (routes 705 / 708) will be **temporarily suspended from operation** at the bus stops below:

- Goodall Street before Stapleton Street (bus stop 2145140)
- Joyce Street opposite Pendle Hill Station (bus stop 2145141)
- Pendle Way at Stapleton Street (bus stop 2145142).

During this period, a shuttle bus service will depart continuously from the intersection of Pendle Way and Civic Avenue to transport passengers to the intersection of Pendle Way and Magowar Road, where they can meet connecting Hillsbus services.

These shuttle services will operate on a continuous loop from:

- 6.15am to 7.45pm Saturday 16 December 2017
- 7.15am to 7.45pm Sunday 17 December 2017.

Passengers may need to allow extra time for their travel on this weekend. Signage will be installed in advance to notify users.

# Changes to parking

To allow for plant and equipment to be delivered and used safely, **parking will be temporarily** unavailable from:

- 10pm Thursday 14 December to 10pm Friday 15 December 2017
  - Joyce Street between Goodall Street and Pendle Way (approximately 30 car park spaces)
  - Wentworth Avenue adjacent to the rail access gate on Wentworth Avenue (approximately 12 parking spaces).
- 10pm Friday 15 December to 10pm Sunday 17 December 2017
  - Joyce Street between Goodall Street and Pendle Way
  - Pendle Way between Joyce Street and Civic Avenue

 Wentworth Avenue adjacent to the rail access gate on Wentworth Avenue (approximately 12 parking spaces).

# What plant and equipment will be used?

- semi-trailers
- mobile lighting towers
- construction trucks
- franna crane
- crane

- concrete saw
- portable generators
- excavators
- power and hand tools
- elevated work platforms

Works may be noisy at times. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to nearby residents and businesses.
