Project Update – Planning Approval

Planning approval for the North Strathfield Station Upgrade has recently been granted and works are set to start in the coming months.

Thank you to everyone who provided feedback during the recent community consultation period. Some of the key themes we heard in your feedback included:

- Support for the project and the new lifts
- Enquiries regarding construction timeframes
- The need to consider how to provide easier access for people with a vision-impairment
- Requests for additional bicycle parking

We are looking to start work on site as soon as possible and site establishment to prepare for construction will begin on **Tuesday 8 January 2019**. This will include installing site sheds, fencing and hoarding.

Project Overview

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Transport for NSW is upgrading North Strathfield Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage. Key features of the station upgrade include:

- three new lifts to provide access to each station platform
- upgrading of existing platform surfaces and surrounding footpaths
- installation of solar panels and updated electronic ticketing
- improved station amenities including an upgraded family accessible and ambulant toilet
- new accessible on-street parking space and upgraded kiss-and-ride area on Queen Street
- upgrades to CCTV and lighting for improved safety and security
