## 2018/19 NON-METROPOLITAN TAXI LICENCE ANNUAL DETERMINATION

Section 71, Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016

I, Clare Gardiner-Barnes, Deputy Secretary, Freight, Strategy and Planning, Delegate of Transport for NSW hereby determine under section 71(1) of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016* as follows

The number of Non-Metropolitan taxi licences to be issued during the year commencing on 1 July 2018 is zero (0).

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxis (section 70).

## Interpretation

In this Determination:

Terms used, other than those defined hereunder, have the same meaning as they do in the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016.* 

'Metropolitan taxi licence' means a licence to operate a taxi in the area of the 'Metropolitan transport district' as defined in sec 108(1) of the *Transport Administration Act* 1988.

'Non-Metropolitan taxi licence' means a taxi licence other than a Metropolitan taxi licence.

'Wheelchair accessible taxi' means a taxi that has wheelchair access as defined in the clause 3(1) of the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017.
