Project update and changes to pedestrian access

Escalators 3 and 4

The replacement of escalators 3 and 4 is progressing as planned, after work in this area began in late May. Signage on the platform is positioned to direct pedestrians towards newly opened escalators 1 and 2 for access between the station concourse and the platforms.

Lift 1 (between the station platform and concourse)

Construction of the lift shaft frame is now complete, allowing the lift car assembly to begin.

Bus canopy extension

The bus interchange canopy extension work is well underway. The western bus bay (Stands C, D and E or first bank of bus bays) will be occupied by construction equipment and materials for a four-week period. There will be a slight reshuffling of bus stands as per the aside image. Bus marshals and signage will be provided to assist commuters to their temporary bus stop location. There will be increased construction during this period with the erection of structural elements and deliveries of large roofing sections and materials. The extension will provide more shade and greater weather protection to those accessing the bus interchange.

New McLean Street ramp

The New McLean Street ramp will reopen from 1 June. Access to the station via the south entrance will return to normal with construction fencing and signage to be removed. Localised barricades remain around the kiss and ride zone in the first few weeks of June while the shelter, seating, bins and bike racks are installed in this area.




Image: Bus interchange changes to pedestrian access diagram.

Out of hours works

Night works will continue within station areas between **8pm and 5am, Sunday through Thursday** throughout the month of June. Noise monitoring will be undertaken to ensure predicted noise levels are adhered to and that appropriate mitigation measures are in place.

Standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm, Saturday**. Works during these hours will occur behind the hoardings or temporary fencing. In consultation with local businesses and residents, we aim to complete all major noisy works and most material movements during these hours. Suitable respite periods and noise reduction methods will be used where possible.
