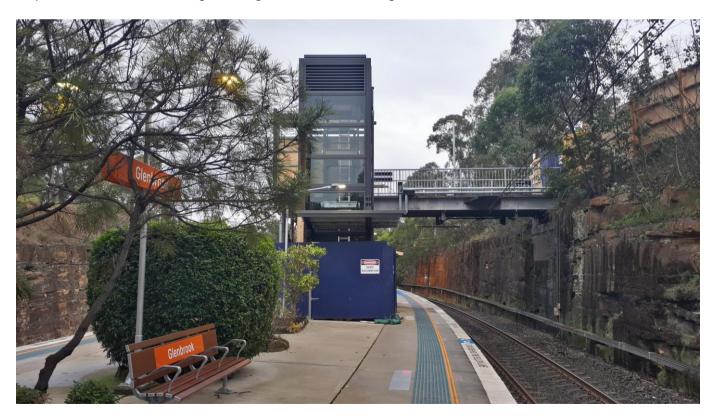
Project update

Throughout June, progress on the Glenbrook Station Upgrade has been continuing, with work starting on the Burfitt Parade station entrance walkway and new stairway. Pile capping construction of this walkway and base slab of the stairway have both recently been completed.

Installation of steel frame for the canopy outside of the family accessible toilet has also now finished, with glazing to be installed over the next few months.

Due to platform re-grading work which took place in May 2019, we have removed and stored the platform garden beds for safe keeping. The garden beds will be reinstated in September 2019.

The station platform lift shaft was installed in late May. The lift will be progressively installed from September and then undergo testing and commissioning.



Upcoming work in July

In July, upgrade work will continue and includes:

- Ongoing installation and testing of a new station transformer
- Ongoing work on stormwater and drainage around the lift structure will be carried out within the enclosed work area
- Ongoing work to install the family accessible toilet and ambulant toilet
- Installation of external walls and handrails at the lift entrance
- Completion of the stairway at station entrance, opening to public at the end of the month

Station access will remain temporarily altered to allow for completion of the new stairs. Signage will remain in place to guide the community during the work. The station will remain open during this time.

Some of this work may be noisy at times and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Standard working hours

Standard work hours are between 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays. We will continue to inform the community ahead of any work outside of standard work hours.
