Project Update - Planning Approval

Planning approval for the Hazelbrook Station upgrade has recently been granted and work is set to start this month, on **Tuesday 29 January 2019.** The works will take around 12 months to complete.

Thank you to everyone who provided feedback during the recent community consultation period. Some of the key themes we heard in your feedback included:

- support for the project and the new lifts
- enquiries regarding construction timeframes
- access to public toilets at the station
- visual and heritage impacts

Project Overview

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Hazelbrook Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage. Key features of the station upgrade include:

- installation of new lift, awning, canopies and lift landing from the existing footbridge
- upgrading commuter car park, footpath and pedestrian crossing and relocation of the bike storage
- regrading of existing platform surfaces and footbridge
- upgrading the existing station amenities to family accessible and ambulant toilet
- upgrades to CCTV and lighting for improved safety and security

Upcoming works

From **Tuesday 29 January to Thursday 7 February**, we will be working on installation of site sheds, fencing and service investigation and relocation. Equipment to be used during this work includes a sucker truck, survey equipment, concrete saw, and hand tools

Standard work hours are between 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays.

Night Work – Monday 4 to Friday 8 February

In February, night work will be undertaken in addition to standard working hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists. From 10pm to 4am Monday 4 February we will be mobilising machinery and equipment around the station. From 7pm to 4am Tuesday 5 to Friday 8 February preparation for installation of lift landing structures will be undertaken. Equipment to be used includes drill rig, concrete mixer, generator, rail machinery and hand tools.

How this work affects you

You can expect this to be noisy at times. However, we will take steps to reduce the impacts where possible. Some of the ways we can minimise noise and impacts include:

- only using noisy machinery when there is no other alternative
- doing noisier work early in the evening when possible
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- notifying residents before the work starts, to let them know what to expect.



During the station upgrade some work may need to be conducted outside of these hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists and minimise impacts on traffic. The community would be informed ahead of any works outside of standard work hours.
