Project Completion Notice

The North Strathfield Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

The North Strathfield Station Upgrade is now complete and the station is fully accessible for all customers.

Transport for NSW and Downer EDI would like to thank the community for their patience during the completion of this important work.

Upgrades to North Strathfield Station included:

- Three new lifts and associated weather canopies to provide access to the platforms and Queen Street from the existing footbridge
- Footbridge connecting Lift 1 at the Queen Street entrance to the existing pedestrian footbridge
- Improved pedestrian pathways between Queen Street, Hamilton Street East and Pomeroy Street
- Provision of one compliant on-street accessible parking space and an upgrade to the kiss and ride space on Queen Street to the south of the station entrance, including new kerb and ramps
- Re-grading and widening of footpaths from the Hamilton Street entrance to Platform 3
- Landscaping throughout the station precinct

- Re-grading and re-asphalting of existing platform surfaces at locations across platforms to provide compliant accessible paths and ramps to station amenities
- Modifications to existing canopies to accommodate the new lift on Platform 3
- Modifications to the existing station building including an upgraded family accessible toilet, unisex ambulant toilet and waiting room
- Platform resurfacing including installation of Tactile Ground Surface Indicators (TGSIs)
- Footbridge and ramp upgrades, handrails and kickplates

- Lighting and electrical upgrades including improvements to the station communications systems (including CCTV cameras), public address and hearing loops
- Power and utility upgrades
- New wayfinding signage throughout the station
