North Strathfield Station Upgrade

Project update

The North Strathfield Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Work completed in September included:

- installation of external walls, roofing and screen to new lift structures
- initial installation of new handrails and shield plating at new lift locations
- installation of electrical and communication systems
- concrete footpath work for the new Hamilton Street access ramp lift located on Platform 3
- installation of lift cars and equipment.

Hamilton Street East

The newly constructed accessible footpath from Hamilton Street East to Platform 3 is now open. Temporary fencing and handrails are still in place on the accessible footpath.

The kiss and ride zones located on Queen Street and Hamilton Street East are also now open for use.

Work planned for October

During October, work will continue on:

- commissioning of newly installed lift cars and equipment
- installation of new handrails and kick plates at the new lifts
- start of landscaping.

Weekend work - Saturday 26 October to Monday 28 October

Subject to approval, weekend work will be carried out from 4am Saturday 26 October to 2am Monday 28 October 2019. Activities will include: regrading of platforms, downpipe and stormwater drainage work, electrical and communications installation, removal of construction hoarding, and completion of lift shafts and new sections of footbridge.

To ensure the safety of our customers, the community and staff, some of this work will be completed during night time.

Platform 3 work and temporary pedestrian detour

Due to the regrading of Platform 3, pedestrian access to the footbridge will be temporarily closed for the duration of this work. The footbridge will be closed from 4am Saturday 26 October to 2am Monday 28 October 2019. A pedestrian detour will be in place via the Pomeroy Street bridge. Signage will be in place to assist the community with this detour.
