North Strathfield Station Upgrade

Project update

The North Strathfield Station Upgrade is progressing well, with activities such as service investigation and enabling works for lifts undertaken in February. In March, the following work will commence:

- excavation and installation of temporary support structures and concrete work for lift pits
- service installation
- installation of hoarding to allow construction of the Queen Street lift to the footbridge.

Upcoming weekend and night work

From 2am Saturday 9 March to 2am to Monday 11 March 2019, weekend and night work will be undertaken in addition to construction in standard hours, during a scheduled Sydney Trains track-work weekend. Activities scheduled to be undertaken during this time include:

- excavation on platforms and installation of new stormwater, power and communication conduits
- installation of new cable conduits on exterior of the existing footbridge
- · concrete pouring for lift pits and shafts.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete and delivery trucks, a concrete pump, mobile lighting towers, a generator, cherry pickers and power and hand tools.

Some of these works may be noisy at times and we have scheduled noisier works for daytime hours to reduce the impacts where possible.

Changes to pedestrian access

Pedestrian access to the footbridge will be maintained during this time, and traffic controllers will be available to assist pedestrians past the areas of work.

From Thursday 7 March to Tuesday 12 March 2019 other work including maintenance may also be happening along the rail line between Strathfield and Berowra as part of the scheduled Sydney Trains track-work shut down.

Footpath closure




Image shows closed footpath
