2020/21 TAXI LICENCE ANNUAL DETERMINATION

Section 71, Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016

I, Joost De Kock, Deputy Secretary, Customer Strategy and Technology, a Delegate of Transport for NSW, hereby determine under section 71(1) of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016* as follows

- 1. The number of Metropolitan taxi licences to be issued during the year commencing on 1 July 2020 is zero (0).
- 2. The number of Non-Metropolitan taxi licences to be issued during the year commencing on 1 July 2020 is zero (0).

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxis (section 70).

Interpretation

Terms used, other than those defined hereunder, have the same meaning as they do in the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016.*

'Metropolitan taxi licence' means a licence to operate a taxi in the area of the 'Metropolitan transport district' as defined in section 108(1) of the *Transport Administration Act 1988.*

'Non-Metropolitan taxi licence' means a taxi licence other than a Metropolitan taxi licence.

'Wheelchair accessible taxi' means a taxi that has wheelchair access as defined in clause 3(1) of the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017.
