

## **2020/21 TAXI LICENCE ANNUAL DETERMINATION**

*Section 71, Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016*

I, Joost De Kock, Deputy Secretary, Customer Strategy and Technology, a Delegate of Transport for NSW, hereby determine under section 71(1) of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016* as follows

1. The number of Metropolitan taxi licences to be issued during the year commencing on 1 July 2020 is zero (0).
2. The number of Non-Metropolitan taxi licences to be issued during the year commencing on 1 July 2020 is zero (0).

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxis (section 70).

### **Interpretation**

Terms used, other than those defined hereunder, have the same meaning as they do in the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016*.

‘Metropolitan taxi licence’ means a licence to operate a taxi in the area of the ‘Metropolitan transport district’ as defined in section 108(1) of the *Transport Administration Act 1988*.

‘Non-Metropolitan taxi licence’ means a taxi licence other than a Metropolitan taxi licence.

‘Wheelchair accessible taxi’ means a taxi that has wheelchair access as defined in clause 3(1) of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017*.
