

Transport Access Program North Strathfield Station Upgrade



North Strathfield Station Upgrade is now complete and the community is able to use the station's new and improved accessibility features.

Customers can use three new lifts to access all platforms and station amenities, including an upgraded family accessible toilet and ambulant toilet. CCTV and lighting have been improved to increase safety and security around the station precinct.

One new accessible parking space and kiss and ride area are available on Queen Street.

The project was completed as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.
