

Transport Access Program **Unanderra Station Upgrade** Planning approval

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station

Planning approval has been granted for the Unanderra Station Upgrade. The approval follows the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors from 20 July - 3 August 2020, and preparation of a Determination Report.

Project overview

Transport for NSW is upgrading Unanderra Station to make it easier for everyone to access the station, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

The project includes:

- three new lifts to connect Berkeley Road (east), Berkeley Road (west) and the station platform to the existing footbridge
- upgrades to the kiss and ride on Berkeley Road (east and west) including seating and improved access paths
- improvements to three existing accessible parking spaces on Berkeley Road (west)
- widening of the existing footpath on Berkeley Road (west)
- new handrails and treads on all stairs
- additional lighting and CCTV.

Design and site preparation work will occur over the coming months, with major construction expected start in early 2021.

Transport for NSW develops initial concept design options for the project, including identification and consideration of environmental constraints, risks and opportunities.



Transport for NSW prepares a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) for public display and invites submissions.



Transport for NSW assesses and responds to feedback and prepares a submission report/determination report with proposed conditions to minimise environmental impacts

Construction Timeframes

Major projects in and around the rail corridor are complex and require careful planning.

For the safety of the community and workers, and in order to minimise disruptions to train services, major construction activities are completed during scheduled trackwork weekends when trains are not running. This means station upgrades generally take longer to build than other construction projects which are located outside the rail corridor.
