Waratah Station Upgrade

Project Update June 2020



June work

Construction on the Waratah Station Upgrade is progressing well, with upgrades to the station facilities and construction of the internal lift cabs, fencing and footpaths continuing throughout May.

Construction activities will continue in June and include:

- platform resurfacing
- upgrades to the existing stairs (Railway Terrace access to station)
- refurbishment of the Station Manager's building
- installation of new services to the station including power supply, drainage and communications
- work to complete the lift roof
- · removal of temporary toilet facilities.

Equipment to be used includes elevated work platforms, mobile crane, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, excavators, power and hand tools.

The refurbished toilets on Platform 2 will re-open on Tuesday 9 June 2020.

Weekend work – Saturday 6 June until Monday 8 June 2020

Work will be carried out between 6am and 10pm from Saturday 6 June until Monday 8 June 2020.

The work will involve a mobile crane and elevated work platform to complete the lift shaft roof and remove the temporary toilet facilities. An excavator will also be used to resurface the platforms and delivery trucks to remove work site barriers at the corner of Railway Terrace and Hanbury Street. Other equipment to be used includes power and hand tools.

The construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work.

This work will be carried out during a scheduled ARTC trackwork weekend when **train services don't operate** and the **station and footbridge is closed**.

Pedestrian and traffic detours

We will undertake work to construct the new landing and access to the stairway on the corner of Railway Terrace and Hanbury Street while the **pedestrian footbridge** is closed from **6am Saturday 6 June to 10pm Monday 8 June 2020**.

When the footbridge is closed, a temporary pedestrian detour will be in place via Railway Terrace and Platt Street. Please allow extra travel time. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with the temporary changes. See the map overleaf for more information.

Night work – power supply upgrade

Night work will be carried out from **8pm to 5am** up to **two nights** between **Sunday 28 June and Sunday 5 July 2020**, to undertake power supply upgrades at the station.

The work will be carried out during a planned Ausgrid power interruption. Residents and businesses affected by the interruption will receive more information from Ausgrid about the timing of each planned power interruption.

Equipment to be used includes a small mobile crane, delivery trucks, elevated work platforms, power and hand tools.


The construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work.

Temporary changes to footpath on Station Street

To facilitate the power supply upgrade to Waratah Station, the footpath on the southern side of Station Street (near Waratah Park) will be temporarily closed while underground work is completed.

Until mid-June, pedestrians will be directed to follow a short diversion through Waratah Park. Please allow extra travel time. Signage will be in place to help pedestrians with the temporary changes. See the map below for more information.

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**.

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
