

Transport Access Program Gunnedah Station Upgrade Have your say

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Gunnedah Station

Planning is underway to improve accessibility at Gunnedah Station to make it easier for people with additional mobility requirements, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage. Feedback on the concept design is invited from **Monday 7 June until Monday 21 June 2021**.

Key features of the proposed upgrade include:

- construction of a paved forecourt area around the station building entry
- upgraded access ramp from the platform to the waiting room
- a new accessible parking space
- formalised coach parking, taxi zone and kiss and ride space
- modification to the waiting room and ticket counter
- improved amenities including ambulant toilets
- a new family accessible toilet
- upgraded seating along the platform
- tactile indicators along the platform
- improvements to wayfinding and lighting.


