## Lapstone Station Upgrade

**Project update**

**February 2021**

### Upcoming work

Construction activities at the station will continue in February including:

- installation of new services at the station platform and surrounding precinct including electrical, communications, water, sewer and gas
- finishing work to station precinct including landscaping, signage installation, fencing and painting work
- installation of internal lift components
- regrading and concrete work within the commuter car park for new accessible parking spaces and the station entrance area
- fit out of the station building.

Equipment to be used during this work includes a mobile crane, small drilling rig, excavators, surveying equipment, delivery and concrete trucks, power and hand held tools.

### Power supply upgrade

Construction work to upgrade the local power supply at Lapstone Station will continue in February. Activities include:

- excavation and trenching to install new underground power supply along Explorers Road and Hume Road
- installing temporary fencing, signage, barriers and other controls around work areas
- removal of up to four trees and vegetation near the commuter car park
- temporary restoration of trenched driveways (permanent restoration to occur in following months).

Equipment to be used during this work includes excavators, delivery and concrete trucks, power and hand held tools.

Temporary access changes on Explorers Road and Hume Road will take place in sections during construction. This includes:

- temporary footpath closures
- temporary driveway closures
- single lane road access and/or on-street parking temporarily unavailable.

Residents and businesses affected by the power interruption will receive information from Endeavour Energy about the timing of the work and how to contact them if you have any questions or need assistance.

## Weekend work – 26 February to 1 March

Work activities will take place **continuously from 6pm Friday 26 February to 6am Monday 1 March**, weather permitting. Work will include platform resurfacing and concrete, roofing and electrical work around the station precinct. Work will also include relocating station entry points and setting up a temporary construction work area within the commuter car park. Traffic controllers will be in place to assist customers.

To maintain the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork, when **train services will not be operating**. Please visit [transportnsw.info](http://transportnsw.info) or call **131 500** for information about replacement buses during this time.

Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, excavators, surveying equipment, delivery/concrete trucks, concrete pumps, construction trucks, power and hand held tools. Measures will be implemented to reduce noise associated with this work, including using non-tonal reversing alarms, turning machinery off when not in use and monitoring noise levels.

**The pedestrian footbridge** across the rail tracks, including connection to the Leonay fire trail **will be closed from 6am Saturday 27 February until 6pm Sunday 28 February**.

## Temporary closure of commuter car park – 3 to 8 February

The lower commuter car park will be temporarily closed from **6am Wednesday 3 February to 6am Monday 8 February** to enable resurfacing work to take place.

Traffic controllers will be in place during this work to assist commuters using car park and pedestrians accessing the station.

## Construction hours

**Standard construction hours are now 7am to 6pm every day including public holidays.**

We understand extending construction hours to weekends and public holidays may cause disruption for the community and all efforts will be made to minimise impacts where possible and ensure strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.
