Pymble Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

July 2021

The Pymble Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Mid-week work – 30 June to 2 July 2021

On Wednesday 30 June between 7am and 6pm, site deliveries and materials will be delivered inside the rail corridor between Station Road and Wellesley Road and Wellesley Road and Fern Street, Pymble to support the weekend work.

Between 7am and 6pm Thursday 1 July and Friday 2 July, we be working on Grandview Street and within the rail corridor at Pymble to undertake site preparation work, non-destructive digging and underground service investigation work. During this period, one taxi rank space on Grandview Street will be temporarily unavailable.

Weekend work – 3 to 5 July 2021

For the safety of pedestrians, customers and motorists, work will take place around the clock from **4am Saturday 3 July to 12am Monday 5 July 2021**. This work will occur during a Sydney Trains trackwork period when the station is closed, and trains are not running. The work includes:

- Excavating and installing new lift piles
- Investigating and relocating existing services to facilitate the future lift installation
- Installing new services within the rail corridor.

Construction plant and equipment will access the rail corridor via the access gates on Grandview Street between Station Road and Wellesley Road and Wellesley Road and Fern Street, Pymble. Temporary pedestrian, taxi and parking changes

- Approximately ten car parking spaces on Grandview Street between Alma Street and Station Street will be temporarily unavailable
- The west bound lane on Grandview Street will be closed periodically during the weekend. A contraflow will be in place under traffic and pedestrian control
- The footpath on the station side of Grandview Street will be temporarily closed east of the station entrance and the taxi zone will be temporarily relocated west of the work site. See map below.

- Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists with all changes.

Construction equipment

Equipment to be used includes two excavators with hammers, hi-rail crane, piling rig, hi-rail dump truck, concrete truck with pump, vacuum truck, work vehicles, concrete saw and various hand and power tools.

This work may be noisy at times. The following measures will be implemented to reduce impacts wherever practicable, including turning off vehicles when not in use, positioning construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible, using non-tonal reversing beepers, and monitoring noise levels. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience during this important work.
