Contract has been awarded

Since receiving planning approval in late 2020, the contract for the design and construction of Unanderra Station upgrade has now been awarded to Degnan Constructions.

Degnan Constructions is delivering the upgrade on behalf of Transport for NSW and will carry out investigations to inform the project design.

Project overview

The Unanderra Station upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, carers/parents with prams and customers with luggage.

Key features of the station upgrade include:

- Three new lifts to provide accessible cross corridor and platform access
- Improved footbridge and stairs
- New kiss and ride zones, accessible parking spaces and bus zones on Berkeley Road (east and west) including seating and improved access paths
- Upgraded station entrances with new pavements, pathways, and landscaping
- Platform modifications, including new boarding assistance zones
- New family accessible toilet, ambulant toilet and services rooms
- Improved station power, services and communications
- Additional station lighting and closed circuit television (CCTV).

Project update – upcoming site establishment

From Thursday 15 April, work will be carried out during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **Saturdays 8am to 1pm**, to set up the worksite.

Work to establish the site compound will involve the use of a tilt-tray truck for delivery and various construction vehicles. This compound will be located off Berkley Road (west), as indicated by the image below. Investigation activities on site are expected to last for up to six weeks, with the majority of this compound being removed from the site once completed. Major work will re-commence on site later in the year.

In the coming months, works at the station will include:

- Geotechnical investigations, including use of drill rigs and vacuum trucks for services locating
- Locating underground services
- Site surveying

This work is not expected to generate elevated levels of noise however, where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise associated with this work, including turning off vehicles when not in use, noise monitoring, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods.
