What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking vegetation maintenance at 54 Thomas Street, Lewisham on Saturday 22 May.

Safety around our electricity network is one of Sydney Trains key priorities. Keeping vegetation, particularly tree branches, clear of powerlines and power poles helps prevent injury to people and damage to property. It also reduces the possibility of interruption to train services occurring.

The vegetation clearance will:

- Minimise the possibility of accidental electrocution
- Reduce the risk of fires caused by electricity
- Reduce the risk of power interruptions caused by branches touching overhead wires.
