Old Canterbury Rd Bridge Lewisham maintenance

What we're doing

Sydney Trains will be completing the repainting of Old Canterbury Road Rail Bridge at Lewisham on Saturday 22 May. This work is essential to prevent corrosion and extend the life of the bridge.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place between 1am and 6am on Saturday 22 May.**
- While we will make all reasonable efforts to reduce noise, please be aware that the painting works involve noisy grinding to prepare surfaces. One-hour respite periods will be provided after each 3-hour block of noisy work at night.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Road closure

- **Old Canterbury Rd will be closed to traffic between Longport and Alfred streets between 1am and 6am on Saturday 22 May.** Detours will be clearly signposted. The detours to cross the rail corridor will be via Liverpool Rd (to the west) and West St (to the east).

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the worksite.
- Work vehicles will access the rail corridor via Alfred and Longport Streets, near Old Canterbury Road.
- While we park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
