Central to Sefton track maintenance

From Friday 28 May to Monday 31 May

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Central and Sefton via Bankstown from Friday 28 May to Monday 31 May.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro are:

- Working within the hoardings on Platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse
- Installing services throughout the station
- Excavating and constructing concrete slabs for the metro platforms (underground former Platforms 13, 14-15).

At Sydenham station Sydney Metro are installing asphalt on Platform 3 and undertaking cladding, roofing and service commissioning work.

Between Sydenham and Bankstown, Sydney Metro will be doing survey and investigations including non-destructive digging, devegetation work, lift shaft footings, piling works, removing redundant assets and installing new overhead wire footings. Activities also include installation of fencing, cable routes, signal equipment, cable laying and pulling. Transmission lines will be installed at Dulwich Hill substation site near Albermarle Street bridge.

Sydney Trains is working on:

- Bridge refurbishment Liverpool Road Overbridge, Yagoona
- Cutting works at Campsie
- Drainage works between St Peters and Sydenham
- Plain Track and Turnout Resurfacing
- Platform refurbishment at Yagoona
- Rail and turnout grinding
- Routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Redfern, Erskineville, St Peters and Birrong
- Track defect removal works at various locations
- Litter and graffiti removal
- Vegetation maintenance.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place around the clock from 10.30pm Friday 28 May until 2am Monday 31 May.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel
 restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
