Blackheath Station Upgrade

Community Update | December 2022 to February 2023

Transport for NSW is improving accessibility at Blackheath Station. The upgrade is expected to be completed in late 2023.

The project is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, which aims to provide station precincts that are accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

Construction is progressing, with the upgrades to the station entrances and kiss and ride area carried out in recent months.

Activities taking place from **December 2022** to **February 2023** will include:

- Installation of services and glass panels, roofing and cladding in the new lift shaft
- Installation of new services in the station building and precinct
- Civil works at station entrances and commuter car park
- Modifications to existing footbridge to facilitate new lift installation
- Door widening works at the station building
- Power supply upgrades

Equipment to be used includes surveying equipment, mobile crane, small drilling rig, excavators, trucks, concrete pumps, power and hand tools.

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Weekend and night work – 18 to 20 February 2023

Work will be carried out during a scheduled Sydney Trains track work period between **12am Saturday 18 February to 7am Monday 20 February 2023**, when the station is closed and no trains are running.

Work will include:

- Installation of precast concrete elements
- Installation of structural steel for new lifts, including roofing, glazing and cladding works
- Commissioning new electrical distribution boards
- Resurfacing of the platform
- Installation of new services within the station precinct

Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, excavators, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, dumpers, elevated work platforms, surveying equipment, construction trucks, power, and hand tools.

Parking and access changes

The station's existing pedestrian footbridge and commuter car park will be closed to ensure works can be carried out safely. Alternative access across the rail corridor will be available at the Bundarra Street level crossing during this time.



Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours.

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We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if additional night or weekend work is required.

What to expect

There may be some noise associated with our work and measures will be implemented to reduce impacts wherever possible, such as turning off vehicles when not in use, positioning construction equipment as far away from residential areas as possible, using non-tonal reversing beepers and monitoring noise levels.
