The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.

Completed work

During January, we started work on the foundations for the new footbridge and lifts. The excavation work began for the lifts, bridge pier and stairs. The new station switchboards were finished and commissioned, ready to service the station upgrades.

Upcoming work

In February, we will continue work in the station building for the new equipment room, ambulant toilet and the station cleaning room. We will also continue work on the new footbridge and lift foundations.

Equipment to be used includes delivery trucks, excavators, rock hammers, concrete pump, bobcats, piling rigs, cranes, and power tools.

Relocation of the 'kiss and ride zone

The temporary 'kiss and ride' zone near the footbridge entrance on Berkeley Road (West) will remain throughout construction.

Changes to the commuter car park



All vehicles will continue to exit directly onto the Princes Highway and some parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable until the completion of the project. There will be signage in the commuter car park directing you to the alternate Council car park on Central Road should you need to use it. Accessible parking has been temporarily relocated to the main car park area.

Pedestrian access

The pedestrian route from the commuter car park to the station is now via the footpath alongside the Princes Highway into Berkeley Road (West). Please allow more time than usual to park your car and walk to the station.

Working hours

To support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has amended the rules around operating hours on work sites. Sites can now operate **seven days a week and on public holidays from 7am to 6pm.** These amendments allow worksites to support social distancing and the health and wellbeing of workers.

To compensate for the delays caused by Covid-19 restrictions, the Unanderra Station Upgrade is using the extended hours, and some weekend work will be taking place on Saturdays in line with the Covid-19 extended hours. We thank you for your ongoing cooperation.
