

# Transport Access Program

## Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification | June 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.

### Completed work

Last month, we continued foundation work for the footbridge, lift and stairs on the Berkely Road West side, waterproofing the lift pit, erecting scaffolding on the Berkely Road East side, excavating and formwork for the bridge and lift foundations. The lift shaft, bridge pier and stair supports are up and halfway complete on the platform.

### Upcoming work

In June, we will be working on all three main areas of the station and platform, carrying out formwork and reinforcing and pouring concrete for the lift shafts, footbridge and stair foundations. Excavation and earthworks will begin in the cul-de-sac on Berkely Road East for the new kiss and ride zone.

## Weekend work

Weekend work will be carried out on **Saturday 18 June and Sunday 19 June.**

For the safety of staff and customers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period, when the station will be closed and no trains will be running. Signage will direct customers to alternative transport.

The work being carried out over this weekend will include:

- relocating the high voltage power supply on the eastern side of the station
- building formwork for the lift shafts, bridge and stairs on the platform and Berkeley Road West

Equipment to be used includes elevated work platforms, excavators, cranes and hand tools.

Out-of-hours work will be required between **6am and 10pm on Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 June.** Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, exercising respite periods during work and using non-tonal reversing beepers. We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience while this work is carried out.

## Working hours

Aside from the weekend work listed above, most work will occur during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm Mondays to Fridays and from 8am to 1pm Saturdays.**

To compensate for delays, we will also be doing some work on weekends between **7am and 6pm on Saturdays and 8am to 6pm Sundays.** The work has been assessed and will not create any excessive noise.

*All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.*

## Commuter car park

There will be no changes to the car park during the weekend work or leading up to this time. All parking will stay as it is now for the next few months.

All vehicles will continue to enter the car park from the Princes Highway via Berkeley Road and exit directly onto the Princes Highway.
