The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.

#### **Completed work**

During February, we continued to work on the new footbridge and lift foundations. We're finalising work in the existing station building, new equipment room, ambulant toilet and station cleaning room and expect to complete them in mid-March.

# **Upcoming work**

This month we'll be working on formwork, concrete pours and waterproofing for the lift pits, bridge piers, stairs and retaining wall.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, air compressors, grinders, delivery trucks and handheld tools.

### **Working hours**

Most of this work will take place during standard construction hours\* between **7am and 6pm Mondays to Fridays and Saturdays 8am to 1pm**.

For improved safety of workers, pedestrians, and commuters we will also be working on weekends in March. Weekend work will take place between **7am** and **6pm on Saturdays and Sundays during March.** 

\*The extended construction hours that have been in place to compensate for the delays caused by Covid-19 restrictions will be ending on 22 March 2022. Standard construction hours from 23 March 2022 will return to **7am to 6pm Mondays to Fridays** and **Saturdays 8am to 1pm**.

## Changes to the commuter car park

All vehicles will continue to exit directly onto the Princes Highway and some parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable until the completion of the project. There will be signage in the commuter car park directing you to the alternate council car park on Central Road should you need to use it. Accessible parking has been temporarily relocated to the main car park area.

#### **Pedestrian access**

The pedestrian route from the commuter car park to the station is now via the footpath alongside the Princes Highway into Berkeley Road (West). Please allow more time than usual to park your car and walk to the station.
