

Transport Access Program Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification November 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.



Scaffolding on the lift shaft on Berkeley Road West has been removed and the stair canopy installed.

Completed work

In October the scaffolding was removed from two of the three lift shafts to reveal the custom-designed concrete finish, which reflects elements from the Illawarra escarpment landscape that can be seen west of the station.

Canopies started being installed across the stairs and landings on the lift shaft. The kiss and ride zone on Berkeley Road East has been completed and was opened for use.

Upcoming work

Work will continue on the third lift shaft and lifts will start being installed in November. Footpaths, kiss and ride zones and accessible parking work will start on the Berkeley Road West side of the station.

In early November we will be pre-building the new footbridge canopies in the rail corridor and commuter car park. Ten parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable for three weeks to safely complete this work. Delivery trucks will be arriving on site between **5.30am** and **7am** some days.

The entrance and exit to the car park will be under traffic control guidance during the day when canopy assembly is being done to ensure commuters have safe access. All work will be packed up at the end of each day and the car park will function as usual, less the temporarily unavailable spaces.

Working hours and weekend work

Work will be carried out between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm Saturdays**. Due to delays work may also be carried out on weekends from **7am to 6pm on Saturdays and 8am to 6pm on Sundays**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.
