

Transport Access Program

Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification September 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

Completed work

Work on both sides of the station and platform continued in August, including the construction of the new footbridge, lifts, stairs and the new kiss and ride zone in the cul-de-sac on Berkeley Road East.

Upcoming work

In September we will continue the next stage of the new footbridge, and the bridge girders will be delivered. Weekend work is planned for early October to put the bridge girders into place and continue work on the footbridge.

The first deliveries of the bridge girders will arrive on **Saturday 3 September**. These will be stored inside the rail corridor and in the car park area already being used by the project. No additional car parking spaces will be used.

Working hours and weekend work

Most work will occur between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and Saturdays between 8am and 1pm**. Due to wet weather delays we will also be carrying out some work on weekends between **7am and 6pm on Saturdays and 8am to 6pm on Sundays**. This work should not create any excessive noise.

Deliveries will be made on **Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 September**. Large cranes will be stationed in the commuter carpark and the rail corridor, and semi-trailers will arrive throughout Saturday and Sunday to deliver the bridge girders. The commuter car park and Berkeley Road West loop road, alongside the station's entrance, will be entirely closed from **7pm Friday 2 September to 12 midnight Monday 5 September** to set up and operate the crane safely.

Weekend work will be happening **6am to 6pm Saturday 1 October and Sunday 2 October** to install the girders for the new footbridge and the steel stair canopies. Equipment to be used includes delivery vehicles, multiple large cranes, elevated work platforms, power tools and hand tools. Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Cranes will be set up in the commuter car park and Berkeley Road West loop between **12 midnight and 6pm Saturday 1 October**, packing down between **6pm and 12 midnight Sunday 2 October**. Other cranes will continue to work and pack up by **6pm Sunday 2 October**.

For the safety of staff and customers, this weekend's work will take place during a scheduled possession.

Changes to the commuter car park

To safely complete the work outlined above, the commuter car park will be closed to allow for the use of the large cranes needed to complete the work.

The car park will be closed from **7pm Friday 2 September to 12 midnight Monday 5 September**. The car park will also be closed from **12 midnight Saturday 1 October** and will re-open at **12 midnight Monday 3 October**.
