

## Transport Access Program Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification December 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

### Weekend work

Work will take place from **6am Saturday 3 December** through to **10pm Sunday 4 December**. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to safely complete essential activities.

This work will be mostly on the platform to install new stormwater pipes as well as some platform work near the new lifts and stairs. This will involve some minor excavation and resurfacing.

Equipment to be used includes delivery vehicles, excavator, compaction gear, concrete pump, power tools and hand tools. Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, and using non-tonal reversing beepers. Respite vouchers may be offered to residents immediately surrounding the out-of-hours working areas.

*All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.*

### How do we consider the community?

The project team understands construction activities may cause some disruption for the community and we will seek to minimise impacts as much as possible. When carrying out our work, the project team uses a noise assessment of the programmed activities to determine the noise to be generated and the appropriate mitigation measures to be put in place.
