

Wollstonecraft Station Upgrade

Public art community consultation update



In August this year, we invited the community to share their thoughts on a public art proposal for a mural at Wollstonecraft Station.

During the consultation period, we received 292 submissions and would like to thank you for taking the time to share your thoughts on the most suitable theme and style for the artwork.

Preferred theme and style – “a celebration of Country”

We are pleased to announce “a celebration of Country” was the most popular theme, with 103 submissions (35 per cent) with a further 86 submissions (29 per cent) choosing this theme as its second or third choice.

The next most popular theme, with 76 submissions (26 per cent), was native flora and fauna and the most popular art style was Indigenous art, with 113 submissions (38 per cent).

Next steps

Considering all feedback received, the theme of ‘celebration of Country’ with an ‘Indigenous art’ style will now inform the artist’s design brief. An artist will be engaged in close consultation with Transport’s Aboriginal Engagement team and other stakeholders, with work on the mural expected to commence in the coming months.
