NEW PARKING OPENS UP FOR LINDFIELD COMMUTERS

15 FEBRUARY 2022

105 new commuter car spaces close to Lindfield Station are ready to be used following the completion the Lindfield Village Green.

This modern new civic space with underground parking and outdoor dining, was officially opened on February 14. Local Member for Davidson, Jonathan O'Dea was pleased to unveil the Commuter Car Park, funded by Transport for NSW, as part of the project.

"Thanks to the NSW Government, over 100 commuter parking spaces have been built to provide easy access to Lindfield Station, just across the road, as well as the Sydney bus network," Mr O'Dea said.

"We were eager to work with Ku-ring-gai Council on this impressive project. The new green space and increased car parking options are wonderful improvements for the local community. Parking for shoppers and commuters was previously in short supply.

"We are committed to creating better access to public transport for the people of NSW. This car park is a fabulous win for public transport users, it is just 50 metres from Lindfield Station and also has electric vehicle charging spaces" Mr O'Dea said.

Opal card-operated boom gates will give access to the commuter spaces. The three level car park has an additional 136 spaces for general parking. Above the car park is an open green space and a pavilion for a café, and new public toilets.

The Village Green was delivered by Ku-ring-gai Council, in partnership with Transport for NSW, who funded the Commuter Car Park. The NSW Government has also committed funding for 135 more commuter car parking spaces in Lindfield as part of the Council's Lindfield Village Hub development.

Transport for NSW's Commuter Car Park Program has delivered more than 11,000 commuter car spaces across Sydney since 2011, with around 7,000 additional spaces on the way.
