Pymble Station Upgrade

Transport for NSW | December 2022 and January 2023

The Pymble Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams, and customers with luggage. We thank you for your patience during this important work.

What's next at Pymble in December and January?

Work will include:

- fit-out of new lifts
- resurfacing the station platforms
- landscaping and installing new furniture
- installing new signage
- removing hoarding and fencing
- installing screens on the footbridge
- resurfacing on the Pacific Highway.

Upcoming works

Work will continue **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm**, and **from 8am until 1pm on Saturdays**.

We will be working outside of standard construction hours over the following weekends:

- **From Monday 5 December to Friday 9 December between the hours of 8pm and 5am**, to facilitate resurfacing work on Pacific Highway
- **From Monday 12 December to Friday 16 December between the hours of 8pm and 5am**, to allow for work on the platform and electrical work within the rail corridor to be carried out

- **From 4am Saturday 14 January to 11pm Sunday 15 January**, to allow for regrading work on the station platforms and installing new furniture.

Holiday closedown period

The site will be closed **from Thursday 22 December 2022** with work resuming on **Monday 9 January 2023**. During this period, we security will be monitoring the worksite and our 1800 number will be operational for urgent calls.

Thank you for your patience over the past year while we have completed work to upgrade Pymble Station.

Pacific Highway traffic lane closure

The southbound kerbside lane on Pacific Highway will be closed **from Monday 5 December to Friday 9 December between the hours of 8pm and 5am**, to allow for resurfacing works to be carried out.

Pacific Highway car park closure

The Pacific Highway car park will be closed over the following periods:

- **From Monday 5 December to Friday 9 December between the hours of 8pm and 5am**
- **From 4am Saturday 14 January to 11pm Sunday 14 January**.

Traffic control will be in place to manage pedestrians and vehicles safely around our work area.



How this work may affect you

We will be using a range of equipment including excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, concrete trucks and pumps, elevated working platforms, jackhammers, grinders, cranes, and various hand and power tools.

Our work will be noisy at times. Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with these works, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Changes to scheduled work

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be significant changes to the construction program.
