## Wahroonga Station Upgrade

### Accessibility upgrade now complete

The upgraded facilities and improved accessibility features are now available to customers including:

- ✓ a new lift connecting the platforms to the existing footbridge
- ✓ a new accessible ramp and walkway between the station and Wahroonga Shopping Village
- ✓ refurbishment of the Redleaf Avenue Bridge and new pedestrian footbridge
- ✓ a new family accessible toilet and unisex ambulant toilet
- ✓ a new canopy for the Platform 1 Boarding Assistance Zone
- ✓ new accessible parking spaces
- ✓ five new bike parking hoops
- ✓ safety and security upgrades including lighting and CCTV security
