

Denistone Station Upgrade

February 2023

The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Denistone Station customers, with an upgraded station accessible to all, including those with a disability or limited mobility, parents and carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Work completed

During the past two months, we have:

- constructed and opened new family friendly toilet facilities on Platform 2.
- constructed and opened the waiting room for Platform 3 and Platform 4.
- completed the construction of lift shafts above the platform level and finished the brickwork around the lifts

Upcoming work

From February to April 2023 we will:

- paint and re-tile the existing waiting rooms.
- install another new, unisex toilet on Platform 1-2.
- install a power pole and kiosk to power the new lifts.
- upgrade drainage for new platform canopies
- improve stormwater discharge at West Parade.
- upgrade existing public carpark at Gordon Crescent and install a new accessible footpath to the station. The carpark will be closed from **Wednesday 15 March** until **early May 2023** to complete these works.
- adjust the station staircase step height and handrails
- install steelwork and precast concrete for the lift shafts and canopies.
- resurface and regrade platforms.

How will this work impact me?

We understand that our work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to lessen the disturbance, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Temporary access changes may be in place during our work hours to safely detour people around the work zone. Thank you for your continued patience and for using caution around the areas of work.

Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Out-of-hours work in March 2023

From **2am Saturday 18 March** until **2am Monday 20 March 2023** there will be out-of-hours work during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. During this work:

- A train replacement bus service will be available.
- The Gordon Crescent station overbridge and parts of West Parade will be closed to vehicles as a crane is used to install steel for the new lifts. Traffic detours will be in place and some on-street parking will be affected. Please follow the signage and the direction of traffic controllers during this period.
