

# More Trains, More Services

## Upcoming work

---

As part of the More Trains, More Services work being delivered at Kiama Station, we will be delivering and lifting a tamping machine into the rail corridor at Gerringong Station between **6pm Friday 2 June and 7am Monday 5 June 2023**.

For improved safety of motorists and to minimise impacts on traffic, this delivery has been scheduled to take place outside of standard construction hours (**7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**).

The delivery and retrieval of the tamping machine is anticipated to take approximately 3 hours respectively, and is not expected to be noisy.

Once lifted into the rail corridor, the tamping machine will be transported via the rail corridor from Gerringong Station to Kiama Station.

A tamping machine is a rail-mounted machine used to pack ballast under the railway, eliminating any voids under the rail sleepers which can occur over time as result of train movements.

## Minimising impacts

The project team understands that construction activities may cause disruption for the community and every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible, including:

- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce potential noise impacts to the surrounding community
- installing noise barriers to shield residents from high impact noise activities
- conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

We would like to thank you, our closest neighbours, for your ongoing support as we work to deliver an improved rail network.
