

Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is building a new substation on Lusty Street in Wolli Creek to create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport Line in the future.

What work are we doing?

In July 2023 the project team will use a bucket truck and hand tools to test the condition of an existing power cable on Bonar Street near the intersection with Thompson Street.

Testing is required to ensure the cable can be integrated with the new electrical network once construction of the new substation has been completed. Testing will not impact power at residential premises.

When we'll be working

Testing of the power cable will occur between 7am and 6pm on Saturday 1 July and Sunday 2 July 2023.

The work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when the power cable can be safely disconnected.

There will also be work inside the rail corridor as shown on the map overleaf from **10pm Friday 30 June through to 6am Monday 3 July 2023**.

What will this mean for you?

Due to safety and traffic approvals, **a road closure will be in place on Bonar Street between Monk Avenue and Thompson Street during the work between 7am and 6pm on Saturday 1 July and Sunday 2 July 2023**.

Access to properties on Bonar Street between Monk Avenue and Thompson Street will be maintained as shown on the map overleaf. If you are a local resident, please advise traffic control at the road closure points that you require local access.

There will also be a **temporary loss of up to three parking spaces on Bonar Street near the work area from 8am on Friday 30 June to 6pm Sunday 2 July 2023** to ensure work can commence as scheduled from 7am on Saturday morning and is not delayed by a parked car blocking the work area. The parking restrictions will be removed as soon as the work is completed.

We thank you for patience during the upcoming work.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community.

We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
