



Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

January and February 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is building a new substation within the rail corridor to create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport Line in the future.

What work are we doing?

In January and February, we will:

- continue to work at the new substation
- install cables, overhead wiring and electrical infrastructure inside the rail corridor
- test and commissioning electrical infrastructure for operational use in the future
- dig holes inside the rail corridor to confirm ground conditions
- remove vegetation inside the rail corridor.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

We'll be working inside the rail corridor and in the site compounds at 5A and 25 Lusty Street.

Out-of-hours work and deliveries

For safety reasons, work and some deliveries will take place outside of standard construction hours when no trains are running from:

- **6pm Monday 5 February to 6am Saturday 10 February 2024**
- **10pm Friday 9 February to 6am Monday 12 February 2024.**

Furthermore, there will be workers at the substation between **6pm and 6am from Monday 22 January to Friday 9 February 2024**. During this period workers are expected to produce minimal noise but you may notice

temporary lighting towers. Every effort will be made to direct the light away from apartment buildings.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- increase in workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- deliveries of machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand our work may cause disruption for the community. We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and follow strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
