



Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

Transport for NSW is building a new substation within the rail corridor to create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport Line in the future.

What work are we doing?

In October, we will continue to work at the new substation to install cables and electrical infrastructure. Our team will also use a vacuum truck to clean an electrical pit located on Spark Lane near Wolli Creek Station and modify existing overhead wiring structures inside the rail corridor.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

We'll be working inside the rail corridor and in the site compounds at 5A and 25 Lusty Street as well as at Spark Lane near Wolli Creek Station as shown on the map overleaf.

Out-of-hours work

For safety reasons, some work will take place outside of standard construction hours from **10pm Friday 6 October to 6am Monday 9 October 2023** when no trains will be running.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and heavy vehicles
- traffic controllers on Spark Lane near Wolli Creek Station and the car park entrance of 9 Brodie Spark Drive to maintain safe access
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand our work may cause disruption for the community. We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and follow strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
