Pymble Station Upgrade

Construction Update | March 2023

The Pymble Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program—to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams, and customers with luggage. We thank you for your patience during this important work.

What's next at Pymble?

During March we will be continuing work on:

- line marking
- removing fencing
- low voltage services
- installing new wayfinding
- landscaping and installing new furniture
- installing screens on the footbridge finalising civil works around our high voltage installations.

Our standard schedule work hours remain as **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm**, and **Saturdays from 8am to 1pm**.

Weekend work

To allow for electrical and structural installation, we have scheduled this work to take place from **6am Saturday 18 March to 6pm Sunday 19 March**.

We have planned our weekend work to coincide with Sydney Trains trackwork. **The station will be closed as trains will not be running.**

Grandview Street closure

Grandview Street between Station Street and Alma Street will be closed on the following dates to allow for work to be carried out safely:

- **Saturday 18 March**
- **Sunday 19 March.**

A detour will be in place via Alma Street and Station Street.

Up to 15 car parking spaces along Grandview Street will be temporarily removed from 4pm Friday 17 March until 11pm Sunday 19 March to enable construction activities to occur and construction equipment to access the work area off the road safely.

Pacific Highway car park closure

The Pacific Highway car park will be temporarily closed from 4am Saturday 18 March to 11pm Sunday 19 March.

Pacific Highway traffic lane closure

The southbound kerbside lane on Pacific Highway will be closed from 4am Saturday 18 March to 11pm Sunday 19 March, to allow for plant and material to access in and out of the Pacific Highway car park.

Traffic controllers will be in place to manage pedestrians and vehicles safely around our work areas and around the closures outlined above.

How this work may affect you

We will be using a range of equipment including excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, concrete trucks and pumps, elevated working platforms, jackhammers, grinders, cranes, and various hand and power tools.

Our work will be noisy at times. Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with these works, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
