

T8 Airport Line Power Supply Upgrade

What work are we doing?

During April and May 2023, work will continue along the T8 Airport Line tunnel from Central to Wollie Creek Junction.

Work includes:

- cable, overhead wiring and utility installations inside the T8 Airport Line Tunnel
- oversized rail infrastructure deliveries to the Gibbons Street site access point in Redfern.

The map overleaf outlines the site access point.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.**

Some work will take place in the T8 Airport Tunnel outside these hours from **2am Saturday 1 April through to 2am Monday 3 April 2023.**

Out-of-hours work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables us to complete the work safely.

All construction work is weather permitting and subject to change.

Out-of-hours deliveries

In connection to the work, there will be several oversized out-of-hours deliveries made to the Gibbons Street site access point between **9pm and 5am from Tuesday 28 March through to Wednesday 5 April 2023.**

What will this mean for you?

There will be **traffic changes on Gibbons Street** (between Marian and Regent streets) **between 9pm and 5am from Tuesday 28 March through to Wednesday 5 April 2023:**

- the inside lane travelling northbound along Gibbons Street will be closed during the night work times outlined above
- traffic control will be in place to direct motorists to merge into the two northbound lanes that will remain open. Please refer to the map overleaf.

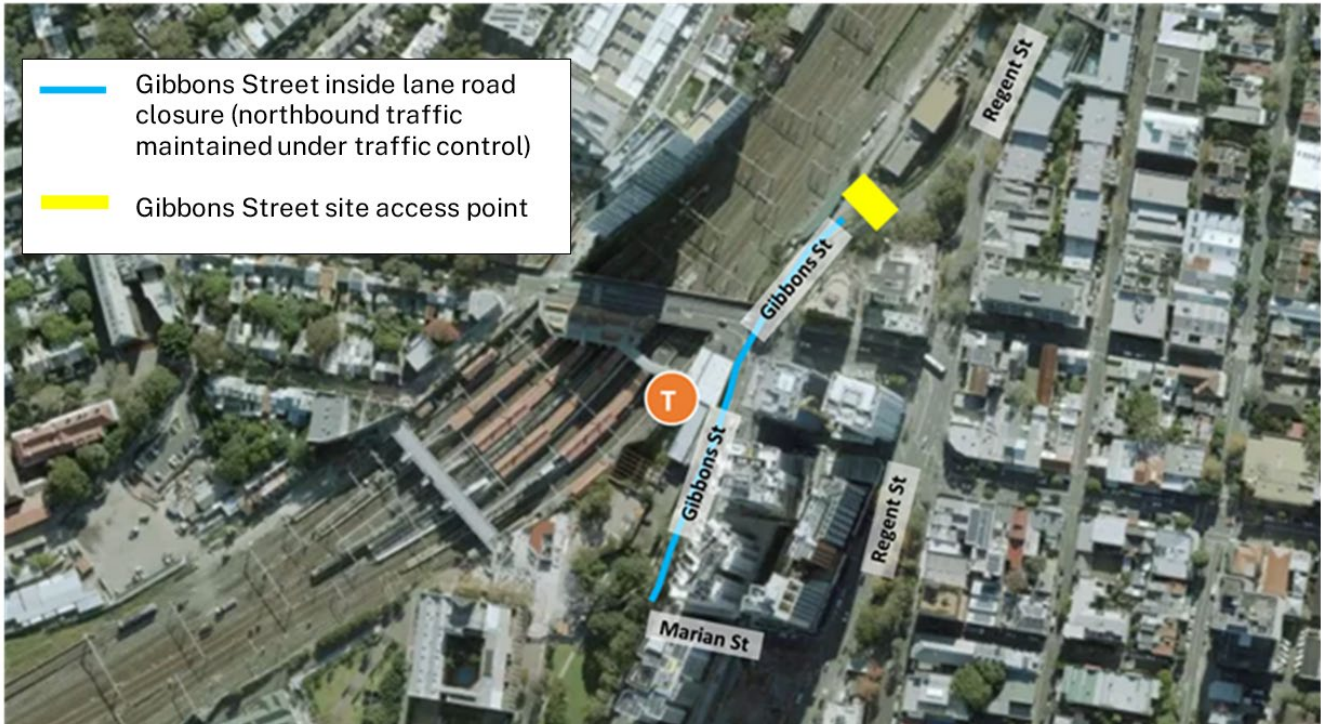
During construction, you may also notice increased workers and vehicles in and near the Gibbons Street access point.
