T8 Airport Line Power Supply Upgrade Project

More Trains, More Services

December 2022 and January 2023

We are upgrading the power supply to support the introduction of the new fleet of trains operating along the T8 Airport Line. It will also future-proof the connection to the Sydney Trains network, allowing more trains and services to be available to customers. Upgrades to the power supply are along the T8 Airport Line tunnel from Central to Wolli Creek Junction.

This notification outlines what work we will be carrying out in December 2022 and January 2023.

What work are we doing?

During December 2022 and January 2023, the project team will carry out cable, overhead wiring and utility installations inside the T8 Airport Line Tunnel. In connection to the work, we will have several oversized rail infrastructure deliveries to the Gibbons Street site access point in Redfern between Marian and Regent streets.

The map overleaf outlines locations of the work and site access points.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Out-of-hours work

Some work and oversized deliveries will take place outside of standard construction hours:

- Between 7pm and 5am on Tuesday 6 December through to Saturday 10 December 2022 and
- Between 7pm and 5am on Monday 12
 December through to Thursday 15 December 2022.

Out-of-hours work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will

be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete the activities safely.

All construction work is weather permitting and subject to change.

What will this mean for you?

During construction, you may notice increased workers and vehicles in and near the Gibbons Street access point.

In connection with the oversized deliveries, there will be traffic changes on Gibbons Street between Marian and Regent streets:

- The inside lane travelling northbound along Gibbons Street will be closed during the out-ofhours work dates and times outlined above
- Traffic control will be in place to direct motorists to merge into the two northbound lanes that will remain open. Please refer to the map overleaf.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- Traffic controllers to maintain safe road management
- Minimising noise as much as possible
- Directing lighting towers away from residential properties to minimise light spill.

Upcoming site shutdown

Work will stop from **Friday 23 December 2022 to Sunday 8 January 2023**. There will be security on site during this period and you may notice small crews carrying out maintenance checks on site. The project team would like to thank you for your patience during our work throughout 2022, and we wish you and your family a happy holiday season.
